Much of the time was spent in Joan getting to know us better, and her getting our responses to her questionnaire about AAUW policies and procedures.

There was no election of new officers as current officers are serving their 2nd term and no one has volunteered to take an open position: Membership VP or Program VP. Branch President Kathy made a speech as to how the Board really, really needs these positions to be filled for the branch to continue to be vibrant. No one present volunteered at that time, but hopefully will do so in the future. The branch also needs new Special Interest Groups to attract new members.

Treasurer Virginia Brown had intended to present a Treasurer Update report, but her computer ran out of juice before being able to do so at the meeting, but provided this information for the newsletter: As of April 30, 2022, the branch's General Fund had a balance of \$1,852.07. The Money Market Fund had a balance of \$5,546.51 which consisted of \$3,033.30 in the McClure Bequest Fund, \$2,500.00 in General Fund reserves, and \$13.07 in Miscellaneous. During the 2021-2022 year so far, the branch received donations valued at \$673.42 form Kathy S. and Virginia B.

 - 2. Pay your dues either by credit card online or by mailing a check.

How to set up your online Personal Portal (AAUW Community Hub)

- 1. Go to <u>Login AAUW</u> or click on the button on the email you received from Katrina Sun Breese, AAUW
- 2. Scroll below the blue log-in button and click "Forgot your password?" link. NOTE: All AAUW members have an account! DO NOT click "Don't have an account?"
- 3. Enter your email address
- 4. Click Reset Your Password to receive your log-in email (If you don't receive this email, email connect@aauw.org for help.)
- 5. When your email arrives, click on the link to set up your password.
- 6. Update your profile. You can do this by **clicking** *My Profile* in the menu on the left side of your *Personal Snapshot* screen

How to Renew Your 2022-2023 Membership by June 30

- 1. When you are ready to renew your 2022-2023 membership, decide if you want to renew by credit card online or by mailing a check.
- 2. If you will renew by credit card online
 - o Go to Login AAUW and log into your Personal Portal.
 - Click the blue Renew button at the bottom to renew your National, State-CO, and Branch-Colorado Springs dues by scrolling down to locate and check each box. (Note: Lifetime members do not pay dues.)
- If you will renew by mailing a check: Mail your check for \$103.00 made payable to AAUW to: Virginia Brown, Treasurer 31845 Willow Bend Road, Whitewater, CO 81527-9608

Members voted earlier this year to increase National dues by \$5. (approximately 42 cents per month for 2022-2023). Our branch dues and AAUW of Colorado dues will not increase.

Our total dues amount is \$103 (\$67 for AAUW National, \$10 for AAUW Colorado State, \$26 for Grand Junction Branch). \$89 is tax-deductible.
